ABOUT ADI KAILASH & OM PARVAT

Adi Kailash (Chhota Kailash) – Facts

- Location: Pithoragarh district, Uttarakhand, India
- Also Known As: Chhota Kailash, Baba Kailash
- Altitude: Approx. 5,945 meters (19,505 ft)
- Nearest Town: Dharchula
- River: Kali River (forms India–Nepal border)
- Mountain Range: Himalayas
- Religious Importance:
Adi Kailash is believed to be the earthly abode of Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati. It is considered spiritually equivalent to Mount Kailash in Tibet.
- Adi Kailash Parvat View:
The mountain resembles Mount Kailash with its distinctive rock formations.
- Om Parvat:
Nearby mountain where a natural snow formation creates the sacred “ॐ (Om)” symbol.
- Best Time to Visit:
May to June and September to October
- Weather:
Cold climate, sudden weather changes, snowfall possible even in summer.
- Permit Required:
Yes, Indian nationals need Inner Line Permit (ILP).
- Difficulty Level:
Moderate to difficult (due to altitude and terrain).

- Mode of Travel:
Road journey + trekking (some routes accessible by vehicle till certain points).

Spiritual Significance

Adi Kailash is one of the five Kailash mountains mentioned in Hindu scriptures. Pilgrims believe that visiting Adi Kailash provides spiritual merit similar to the Kailash Mansarovar Yatra.

Adi Kailash & Om Parvat Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Delhi to Pithoragarh (via Tanakpur Route)

- Morning pickup from Delhi
- Drive to Pithoragarh via the scenic Tanakpur route
- Enjoy beautiful views of rivers, hills, and valleys during the journey
- Arrival at Pithoragarh by evening
- Check-in at hotel
- Rest and relaxation
- Dinner and overnight stay at Pithoragarh

Day 2: Pithoragarh to Dharchula

- Early morning breakfast at the hotel
- Drive to Dharchula, a picturesque town located on the India–Nepal border
- Distance: approx. 95 km
- Travel Time: around 4–5 hours

- Dharchula lies on the banks of the Kali River, which separates India and Nepal
- Visit the International Suspension Bridge connecting India and Nepal
- Optional short visit to Nepal side (as per local rules)
- Explore Dharchula local market
- On the same day, Inner Line Permits for Adi Kailash and Om Parvat will be processed and issued
- Dinner and overnight stay at Dharchula

Day 3: Dharchula to Gunji (via Adi Kailash Region)

- Early morning breakfast
- Drive towards Adi Kailash region
- En route visit:
 - Adi Kailash Parvat (Chhota Kailash) Darshan
 - Parvati Sarovar
 - Gauri Kund
 - Other nearby spiritual and scenic sightseeing points
- Experience the divine and peaceful surroundings of the Himalayas
- Continue journey to Gunji village
- Check-in at homestay / guesthouse
- Dinner and overnight stay at Gunji

Day 4: Gunji to Om Parvat – Return to Dharchula

- Early morning breakfast
- Proceed towards Om Parvat

- En route sightseeing:
 - Kali Parvat
 - Sheshnag Parvat
 - Vyas Gufa (associated with Sage Ved Vyasa)
- Darshan of Om Parvat, famous for the natural snow formation in the shape of “ॐ”
- Special Note:
If permitted by the Indian Army and local authorities, pilgrims may get an opportunity for Kailash Mansarovar Darshan from the viewpoint (subject to on-the-spot permission and weather conditions)
- After darshan, drive back to Dharchula on the same day
- Dinner and overnight stay at Dharchula

Day 5: Dharchula to Delhi (Return Journey)

- Early morning departure after breakfast
- Drive back to Delhi via the same scenic route
- Tour concludes with divine memories of Adi Kailash & Om Parvat Yatra



Inclusions

- Pickup and drop from Akshardham New Delhi
- Accommodation in hotels on triple-sharing basis and homestays on multi-sharing basis
- Comfortable transport as per itinerary (Sedan / Ertiga / Tempo Traveller / Bolero Camper)

Important Guidelines for Yatris

- Any new tax, entry fee, permit charge, or levy imposed by government or administration shall be payable by the traveler.

- No-show, route change, or yatra cancellation due to bad weather or natural calamities is non-refundable.
- If an extra day is required due to unforeseen circumstances, additional charges will apply.
