POPULARLY REFERRED TO AS THE 'MINI SWITZERLAND' OF UTTARAKHAND, CHOPTA (AT AN APPROXIMATE ALTITUDE OF 2,608 M) IS A SLICE OF PARADISE TUCKED AWAY IN THE GARHWAL HIMALAYAS. SURROUNDED BY BUGYALS OR VELVETY MEADOWS AND PRISTINE SNOW-CAPPED PEAKS,

CHOPTA IS AN ALL-YEAR HOLIDAY DESTINATION: PLEASANT IN SUMMER, RAIN-FRESH IN MONSOON AND A SNOW-CLAD FAIRYLAND IN WINTER. CHOPTA IS AT THE EPICENTRE OF THE PANCH KEDAR- THE FIVE MOST SACRED SHIVA TEMPLES IN THE STATE. ON ITS LEFT ARE LOCATED KEDARNATH AND MADMAHESHWAR SHRINES AND ON THE RIGHT, RUDRANATH AND KALPESHWAR, AND JUST ABOVE IT, THE TUNGNATH TEMPLE

DAY 1 DEPARTURE FROM DELHI

- Trek down from Chandrashila and in evening back to camps, Have dinner & overnight stay in camps



DAY 3

TREKKING TO DEORIA TAL | DELHI DEPARTURE

- Wake Up early in morning & witness the beautiful sunrise.
- Have breakfast in camps and check-out from the camps.
- Head to Sari village (starting point of deoria tal trek). Start the trek passing through the village and have a wholesome experience.
- Enjoy the beautiful lake surrounded by pines, In noon Back to the Sari Village & depart to the Delhi by 4, in evening.
- Reach Delhi the next day morning by 7am (approx.), the trip will end here with sweet memories and friends for life.
